RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Gob Cake

Ingredients:

Cake

1 box Devils Food Cake Mix plus eggs, oil and water as called for in cake instructions

In addition:

2 egg yolks

¼ cup oil

1 box chocolate instant pudding

Filling:

2 egg whites

1½ cup sugar

¾ cup evaporated milk

1½ sticks butter, softened

¾ cup Crisco

3 Tbsp Vanilla

Prepare cake mix as directed adding additional egg yolks, oil and pudding. Divide into two prepared jelly roll pans and bake at 350 for about 15 minutes.

Using a stand mixer, beat egg whites until stiff. Add sugar, evaporated milk, butter, Crisco and vanilla. Cream well. Icing will look separated for a long time then all of sudden turn creamy.

Top one of the cooled cakes with filling then carefully place the other cake on top. Keep refrigerated.

This recipe was given to me by a coworker at Camp Harmony, Sandi Ott and is common in West Central PA. This is what I normally prepare for funeral meals.
