## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Strawberry Pretzel Salad  
Submitted by Doug Diamond

1 6 oz box Strawberry Jello  
2 10 oz boxes of frozen strawberries (I can't find boxes, I buy two tubs and use about 1 and a half)  
1 med can crushed pineapple, drained  
2 cups of pretzels (crushed)  
3T sugar (for 1st layer)  
1 8oz pkg of cream cheese  
1 cup sugar (for 2nd layer)  
2 8oz Cool whip  
2 cups of boiling water

1st layer  
2 cup crushed pretzels  
3 T. sugar  
3/4 cup butter

Mix together in bottom of 13x9 inch pan. Bake 7 minutes at 400 degrees  
Cool

2nd layer  
1 8oz pkg of cream cheese  
1 8 oz Cool Whip  
1 cup sugar

Blend and spread over cooled crumb crust.

3rd layer  
Mix jello and 2 cups boiling water with frozen strawberries and pineapple (you can add blueberries, too). Set aside until partially set. Spread over 2nd layer. Let jello set up, cover top with cool whip and then serve. Keep refrigerated.

This recipe is from my sister-in-law, Gail Diamond. It is called a salad so it must be good for you!
