RECIPE OF THE MONTH



- 1 Pumpkin, (8-10 pound)
- 2 tsp. ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp. ground cloves
- 3 C sugar
- 1/2 tsp. ground nutmeg

Cut top from pumpkin, scoop seeds out. Replace top, bake on pan with sides. Bake 325 degrees till tender, (3 hours). Leave pumpkin in pan, cut in half to allow liquid to drain into pan. When pumpkin is cool, scoop out pulp, discard saving pumpkin seeds if desired. Put thru food mill or purée in blender. In 4-6 quart Dutch oven combine purée, 1/2 C water and 2 tsp. salt. Cook uncovered over medium heat until mixture is reduced to 6 cups. Stir often. Stir in sugar and spices. Bring to full rolling boil. Simmer uncovered till thick, (15-20 minutes). Consistency should be that of our Fellowship Apple Butter. Remove from heat and pour and seal into 1/2 pint jars. Store in refrigerator after cooled. May be processed in water bath canner for 10 minutes to keep longer on shelf.
