RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Baked Pineapple Casserole

- 1 C sugar
- 6 T all purpose flour
- 2 C grated sharp cheese
- 2- 20 ounce cans of pineapple chunks, drained, (Reserve 6 T juice for later)
- 1 C Ritz cracker crumbs
- 8 T, (1 stick) butter, melted
- Butter to grease pan

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease a medium casserole dish with butter. In a large bowl, stir sugar and flour together. Gradually stir in cheese. Add drained Pineapple chunks and stir until ingredients are well combined. Pour mixture into prepared dish. In another bowl, combine cracker crumbs, melted butter and reserved Pineapple juice. Spread mixture on top of pineapple mixture. Bake for 25-30 minutes or until golden brown. Enjoy.
